#### **3.** Attendance of Graduands

- **3.1** As stated in the UPM Convocation Ceremony matters, degrees and diploma will only be conferred to Graduands attending the convocation ceremony, provided that the Senate may, in exceptional circumstances, allow a degree or diploma conferred in absentia.
- **3.2** Graduands must comply with the instructions related to their sessions and are **not allowed to postpone or nominate representative** to attend the convocation ceremony on their behalf.
- **3.3** Graduands who wish to attend the 48<sup>th</sup> Convocation Ceremony are required to join 48<sup>th</sup> Convocation Official Telegram <u>https://t.me/+TbqzAaq4X\_RjMDY1</u> for information, updates and video entitled 'Convocation Ceremony at UPM: Guide for Graduands' and 'Steps on how to wear UPM Academic Regalia'.

#### 4. Graduation Fee

**4.1** A graduation fee of **RM200.00** (Malaysian Ringgit: Two hundred only) is compulsory for all graduands (full-time, part-time/distance learning [PJJ]/trimester/executive programs), which includes those not attending the convocation ceremony.

**4.2** Payment of the fee must be made **at least two (2) working days** before updating the information in the e-SMP (My Convocation) through the payment method as listed below:

# 6. Borrowing the Academic Regalia

# 6.1 Borrowing Process

Graduands are required to:

- a) pay the graduation fee as indicated in item 4.2 above
- b) complete the Academic Regalia form vie e-SMP MyConvocation menu (postgraduate student may log in to SMP using your UPM-ID/Matric number and password for IGIMS) starting on 1<sup>st</sup> November 2024 (Friday);
- c) **input payment information** and height measurement (size of the regalia will be based on the height);
- d) print the Academic Regalia form and Graduate Tracer Study Slip, and bring them along to the regalia collection (walk-in); and
- e) prepare a representative authorisation letter if sending a representative to collect the regalia (each representative is restricted to two transactions only). Please provide printed copies of academic regalia form and any applicable NRIC/ passport (refer <u>APPENDIX</u> 2) (if any).

Attention: 7<sup>th</sup> December 2024 is the last day to return academic regalia.
 Penalty will be imposed to graduates starting on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day after the convocation ceremony for each graduate's designated session.
 Strict actions will be taken against graduates who fail to return academic regalia within the specified time.

- 7.2 **Penalty** will be imposed as follows:
  - a) RM10.00 on the first day of the late return (the third day after graduate's designated convocation session) and an additional RM5.00 for each subsequent day
  - b) Penalty payment shall be made at Bursar Counter 3, Ground Floor, Putra Chancellery Building, UPM OR via Payment Gateway and payment receipt must be presented upon returning academic regalia
- **7.3** Representative who returns the academic regalia on behalf of the graduates must receive the endorsement at the counter before leaving.
- **7.4** Graduands are responsible for any damaged or loss of academic regalia borrowed; and
- **7.5** Any damages or lost items will be charged and scroll/transcript will not be released until the payment has been made. The charges are as follows:




